- 1. Seafarer's full name
- 2. Nationality
- 3. Copy of passport
- **4.** Copy of seaman's book
- 5. Job position on board
- 6. Copy of Fit-for-Duty certificate
- 7. Vessel name
- 8. Vessel IMO number
- 9. Copy of employment (labor) contract
- Copy of collective bargaining agreement (CBA)
- **11.** Type of injury suffered
- 12. Date of accident
- **13.** Date of disembarkation
- **14.** Detailed description of how the accident occurred
- **15.** Copy of post-accident medical report
- **16.** Type of treatment received (on board and ashore)

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS IF CLAIM IS BY SURVIVING HEIRS

Include items 1-16, plus the following as applicable:

- A. If the seafarer was unmarried and had no children, heir is a parent:
 - Parent's passport copy (claiming on behalf of the seafarer)
 - 2. Seafarer's birth certificate (showing relationship to parent)
- B. If the seafarer was married and/or had minor children:
- **B1**. If married (spouse claims for self and on behalf of children)
 - 1. Marriage certificate
 - 2. Children's birth certificates
- **B2.** If unmarried with minor children (children claim through guardian):
 - 1. Children's birth certificates
